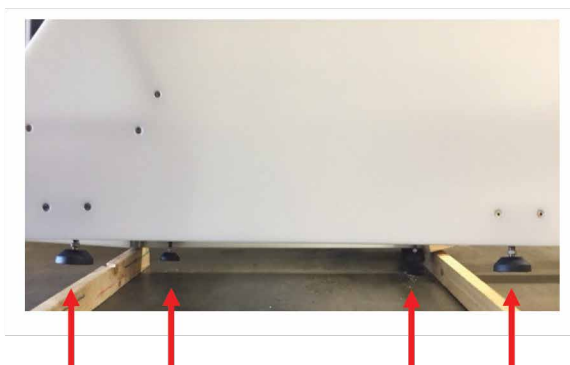


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PELICAN POOL STEPS

Earthing: As per AS3000 of the wiring rules standards – “In certain circumstances” it may be necessary to have all conductive metal objects equally potentially bonded (earthed), this includes Pool Hoists.

We recommend you seek the advice and opinion of a qualified electrician.

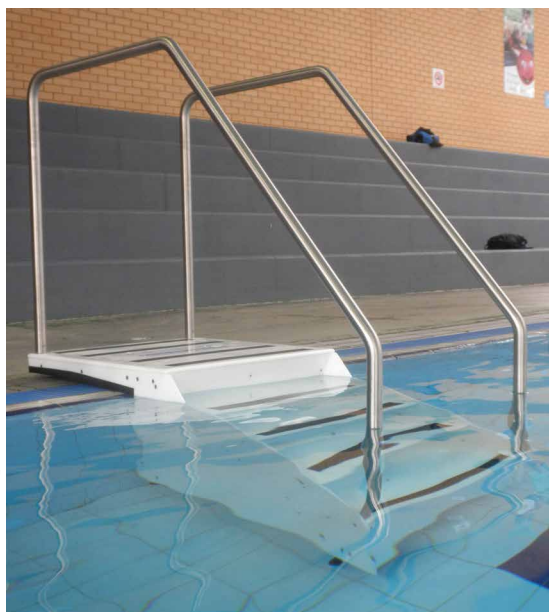
- Your Platypus Pool Steps will arrive on a pallet.
- Carefully unpack the steps and transfer using the included dolly wheels to the area set out for the steps.
- Lower the steps into the pool, this will require the help of someone in the pool.
- All four adjustable feet must be touching the bottom of the pool.
- They can be adjusted by using two spanners.
- The top platform of the steps that sits on the pool deck must also be sitting level on the pool deck.



All four feet can be adjusted by using two spanners.

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Two spanners

ENTERING THE POOL

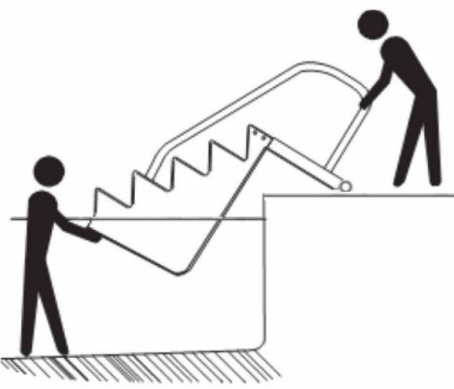

REMOVING THE STEPS

Removing the steps is always a two-person job.

Attach the Dolly Wheels to the standing platform before moving. Please use caution and care when removing the steps from the pool so as not to injure yourself.





CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Para Mobility only use 316 grade Stainless Steel to manufacture our products, due to the corrosion or oxidation (rust) resistant properties.

Tea Staining is a discolouration of the surface of the stainless steel, and occurs in higher temperatures and humid conditions. Whilst having the same look as rust, Tea Staining does not affect the structural integrity or the longevity of the material. Visually it is a discolouration of the surface, which tends to follow the "grain" of the surface finish.

To ensure your pool steps continue to look great and avoid tea staining we recommend washing the area regularly using clean fresh water and mild detergent using a cloth or soft brush.

After washing rinse off with clean water and wipe the surface dry with a soft absorbent cloth.

DO NOT use abrasive cleaners or a scouring pad of any type as they may cause scratching, damage, excessive wear and dull the finish.

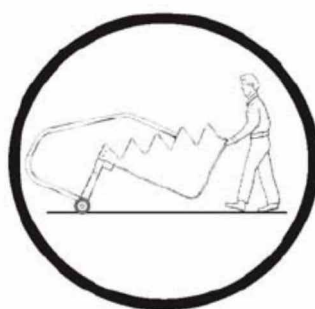
DO NOT use waxes or furniture polish.

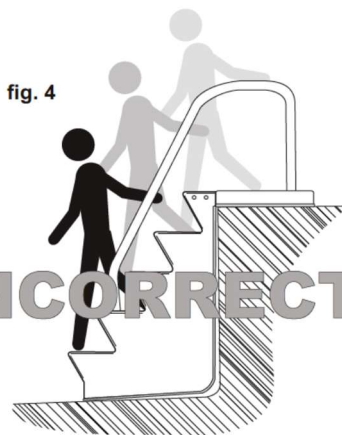

Removing the steps is always a two-person job.

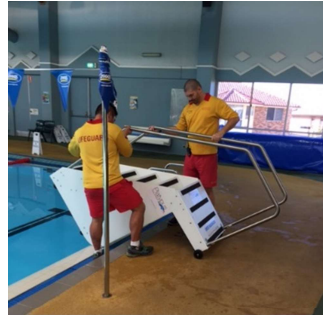
Attach the Dolly Wheels to the standing platform before moving.
